

\$1.4B in posh projects planned in Victoria

A 1,000-home plan for Greater Victoria's posh Bear Mountain resort has been announced by the Quigg Group of Vancouver.

Known for its high-end developments in the Vancouver area, Quigg has set a \$1.4-billion budget for what it's calling "two long-term projects."

Condominiums on a 20-acre hilltop are first on the developer's agenda. Suite sizes would range from 850 to 5,000 square feet. The Quigg projects would represent a major chunk of the Bear Mountain development project on 526 hectares.

It would eventually have more than 1,000 single-family homes, 4,000 condominiums, and 285 townhouses. Golf, restaurants, a spa, hotel, and a village are also part of the development.
